Often a small, affordable loan can make a big difference to working families.

The Child & Family Services Ways To Work Loan programs provide loans designed to help working families reach their goals of maintaining employment and completing college.



Loans from \$500 to \$4,000 are provided for the purposes of purchasing:

- Computers, necessary appliances, furniture or medical care
- Child Care or Day Camp Services
- Housing needs such as security deposits, rent or mortgage arrears, or repairs
- Vehicle repair or purchase
- Equipment necessary for self-employment

You qualify to apply for a loan if you:

- Reside in Erie County
- Are an involved parent(s) of a dependent child
- Cannot qualify for a loan from a bank or credit union at a reasonable rate of interest
- Work for at least six months, 20 hours per week or attend college taking at least 9 credit hours beyond the first semester
- Have a valid license that has not been suspended or revoked within the last two years, if applying for an auto loan.
- Demonstrate an ability and intent to repay the loan in a timely manner and develop a positive credit history.

Loans are available to qualified families regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, marital status or age.

How can I apply?

1. Simply call 335-7400
2. Participate in an Orientation Session online or in person.
3. Complete the loan application and schedule an appointment.
4. Review the loan application with a counselor. (There is a \$20 fee.)

After review, your application is submitted to the Loan committee for consideration. Upon loan approval, additional information is verified and the servicing bank will make a check payable to you. All monthly payments are made by you directly to the bank.

The Wheels For Work Loan Program provides loans up to \$4,000 for vehicle repair or purchase to low income parents who work at least 20 hours per week. The program is funded by the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance.
